MESSAGE FROM MRS JONES

We have our harvest festival next week (Tuesday 10th October) at school. ACTIVE SCHOOL UNIFORM

Please note the correct active school uniform for your child. Aside from the school logo, any logo or stripes on uniform are not allowed.



- Year 3 only the 1/4 zip top can be worn (as seen above) no plain zip tops or hoodies.
- Years 4-6 continue to wear burgundy jumper / cardigan / fleece.
- Plain black trousers, leggings, shorts and skorts can be worn, as well as than the red/black branded items above.
- No logos / stripes will be allowed on any item of clothing (Nike, Adidas, Puma) and no skins, or other layering to be worn under the active uniform please. The only logo allowed is the St Michael's School logo.
- Socks must be white, grey or black.
- Years 4-6 -existing grey / white school uniform can still be worn on non-PE days

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MEDICAL APPOINTMENTS

We understand that it can be difficult to sometimes get medical / dental appointments for your children but where possible, please could they be taken outside of school hours. A medical appointment form needs to be filled in along with proof of the appointment.

HAIR / NAIL POLISH / JEWELLERY

HairIf your child has long hair, it must be tied back.Nail polishIt is school policy that children are NOT allowed to wear nail polish to school.JewellerySchool policy allows your child to wear one pair of small stud earrings to school.A necklace is allowed for religious beliefs only.

SCHOOL TRIPS

All children have the opportunity to go on school trips throughout the year. Whilst we ask for voluntary contributions towards these trips, we obviously need to cover the cost of the trip. In 2022/2023 the school had to fund over £7,000.00 owing for school trips.

SICKNESS

If your child is sick, we ask that you call the school office first thing in the morning to let us know why your child is off. If your child has a headache or sore throat, we recommend giving them medicine before they come to school. Children with diarrhoea or vomiting should stay away from school for 48 hours after the last episode.
