Please help us to help others and raise much needed funds for our school. Our last collection in May raised £117.00 for the school so thank you for your continuing support.

### **ANTI BULLYING WEEK**

Next week (13<sup>th</sup> November) is anti-bullying week. The school takes all forms of bullying seriously as it is a life changing event for those involved. We believe it is really important that children and parents/carers understand what bullying is so that no one trivialises it.

The definition we use with the children is: 'Bullying is the repetitive, intentional hurting of one person or group by another person or group, where the relationship involves an imbalance of power. It can happen face to face or online.'

It is important that everyone understands that a one-off incident, although unpleasant is not bullying. The reason bullying is so harmful and life changing for those being bullied is that it happens over time, it is done intentionally to harm someone and those doing the bullying have power over those being bullied.

### **BINGO**

Thank you to everyone who came to the bingo on Thursday evening, we had around 140 people attending. It was such a fun event. Thank you to Mrs Porter and Mr Wilson for organising it and thank you to those who stayed to help us pack away at the end it was done so quickly. The event was not to raise money, just to bring us together as a school community and it certainly did that! The raffle raised enough money to cover the cost of the event and to go towards the snacks and drinks at the next event.

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#### **FOOTBALL BOOTS**

If you have any football boots that are still in good condition that your child has grown out of or no longer wears, please could you donate them to the school. We have children who want to play in matches but don't own football boots. It is so useful to have spare ones to use for matches.

#### **EARA (EQUALITY AND RIGHTS ADVOCATES)**

We are launching the EARA project (Equalities and Rights Advocates) at school. I talked to the children about the project and setting up a group of 12 children who would be our EARA. I invited the children to apply to be on the group. I have had 30 applications so far. The applications I have received are amazing and make us so proud of the children at the school. I thought you might like to see some of the comments:

I want my friends to be safe and happy at school and everyone to be give the same chances;

We are all unique and different from each other but every one of us should have the same opportunities as each other;

I want to live in a world without discrimination, a world where everyone is treated with respect, a world where everyone has the opportunity to access their untapped potential.
