MESSAGE FROM MRS JONES

This has been a busy week, with Remembrance Day on Monday, anti bullying week, a visit from the Mayor of Aldershot on Thursday who enjoyed a tour of the school by our Ambassadors, and ended with a non-school uniform day in aid of Children in Need on Friday. Due to your kind donations, we have raised £227.00 for Children in Need.

At our Remembrance Day Worship assembly on Monday, service parents who are or were in the army were invited to wear their uniform and share with the children about their roles in the army. A big thank you to all the parents for giving up your time and taking part in the assembly. Our children and staff commented on how much they enjoyed it and what a great way to commemorate Remembrance Day as

a school.



As it has been Anti-Bullying week 2024 this week, the children revised the definition of bullying (repeatedly, intentionally, hurting someone where there is an imbalance of power) and looked at choosing respect.

COLLECTIVE WORSHIP

Our Collective Worship this week focussed on Remembrance Day. We looked at the history of poppies and how in the first year they were introduced (1921) 9 million were sold, raising £106,000 to help veterans with housing and jobs. We then heard from parents in our school community about their roles and experiences of being in the army. This enabled the children to understand more about what Remembrance Day is about.

SCHOOL REMINDERS

What should I do if I need to take my child out of school for medical appointment?

Standard medical or dental appointments should be made outside school hours. If a child is absent for a medical appointment, it is still regarded as an absence from school.

Please make sure the school are notified of any medical appointments in advance. Parents/carers will need to fill in a **medical appointment form and also provide proof of the appointment**. If we do not see proof of the appointment, then it will be unauthorised. Any optician appointments taken during the school day will be unauthorised.

Where there is no alternative for an appointment outside of the school day, children should only miss a short period of time and return to school as promptly as possible.

What should I do if my child is absent from school?

If your child is absent from school, you must contact the school **daily**. This can be done by calling 01252 322933 and selecting option 1, or by email to **adminoffice@st-michaels-jun.hants.sch.uk** with the following information; child's name, year group and reason for their absence (for example high temperature or sickness bug).

If a child has been sick or have diarrhoea, they must stay off school until they have been free of symptoms for 48 hours.

All absences must be reported to the school office on each day of illness by 8.50am. If we do not receive a message regarding a child's absence, we will telephone and if necessary, text to ask for an explanation. If we are unable to contact you, we will keep trying and also contact other emergency contacts. The absence will be marked as unauthorised until we have spoken to a parent to clarify the reason.

PARKING

We thank those parents who park considerately when they are dropping off or collecting their children. Unfortunately, there are still a few parents who are parking inconsiderately. Parents cannot park on private property, cannot park on yellow lines and cannot block driveways.

As a result of what we have seen and been told about, the traffic enforcement officers are going to be attending regularly and Hampshire's Travel Planning Team are coming out to review the situation. Please leave enough time to park considerately and accept that you may need to walk a distance from your parking space.


SCHOOL INFORMATION

YEAR 5 SEACITY MUSEUM: FRIDAY 6TH DECEMBER 2024

Year 5 will visit the SeaCity Museum Southampton as part of this term's work on Titanic. The children will be taking part in various activities related to Titanic.

The visit will take place on Friday 6th December, leaving school at 9.00 am, travelling by coach and returning to school by 3.20 pm. The children will need to be in school for registration by 8.35 am to enable a prompt departure.
