SCHOOL INFORMATION

NASAL FLU VACCINATION - Tuesday 9th December

From the NHS School Age Immunisation Service

Your child's annual Nasal Flu Vaccination is now due. The vaccine helps protect against flu, which can be a serious or life-threatening illness.

Click the link below for the electronic form and information about the vaccine. You will need to input the School Code below to complete the form. Access to the form will close two working days prior to the session.

The nasal flu vaccine contains products derived from pigs (porcine gelatine). To opt for the porcine gelatine free inactive flu injection, select NO to the nasal flu immunisation and you will be given further options. More information for parents is available from www.nhs.uk/child-flu.

Alternatively, if you decide you do not wish your child to receive the vaccine against flu, please complete the form to record your decision. This will enable us to update your child's immunisation record.

COATS / WATER BOTTLES

As we move into Autumn please send your child to school with a named hooded raincoat and a water bottle (clearly labelled with your child's name) to school each day. Children will have the opportunity to refill if they need to.

WEARING OF JEWELLERY IN PHYSICAL EDUCATION LESSONS

PLEASE NOTE that our school policy states that the only jewellery a child is permitted to wear is a plain small wrist watch and/or plain small studs for earrings. Other items are not permissible in school. Pupils with earrings must remove them for PE. Taping of earrings is not an option.

CROSSING PATROL

Please note that there is still no School Patrol Crossing until further notice. It is important to note that School Crossing Patrols are a non-statutory service and from a legal perspective, responsibility lies with parents to get their children to and from school. Please can we remind all parents and carers to please take appropriate measures to ensure your child's safety while travelling to and from school.

Parking responsibly

As with the majority of junior schools, we do not have a 'parent' car park. If you do need to drive to drop off or collect your child please park considerately and ensure you are not obstructing drives, garages or access to roads. Please be respectful of our neighbours and remember that parking on ziz-zag lines at any time of the day is prohibited.

Our children's safety is our main priority and this includes their journey to and from school. We appreciate your support in this matter.

YEAR 3: 'THROUGH THE AGES' THEATRE WORKSHOP

As part of our topic 'Through the Ages', we will be having a theatre workshop in school run by Theatre Exchange. During the workshop, the children will take part in different activities to build their understanding of what life was like during the Stone Age, Bronze Age and Iron Age. This is an interactive way for the children to learn facts about this period in History.

The workshop will take place in school on Monday 10th November with each class taking part in a workshop during the day. In order for these workshops to go ahead, a voluntary contribution of £4.40 is requested to contribute towards the cost of the company coming in and delivering this unique experience.

Payment can be made via your Scopay account or cash (handed into the school office). If insufficient contributions are received, the visit may have to be cancelled.

PARENT EVENT

Year 3 parents and carers are invited to join their child and take part in a Parent Event on Maths and Timetables on Wednesday 10th December 2025.

This event will be held in the school hall and will take place from 1.30-3.00pm, which will allow those to collect younger siblings from the infant school. Other parents can wait on the playground until 3.20pm so that the children can be dismissed from classes in the usual way.

Please note, this is not a drop in Parent Event so please arrive promptly. The pedestrian gate will open at 1.25pm close at 1.40pm. Due to the nature of this activity, latecomers will not be admitted. We look forward to seeing you there.

YEAR 4 SWIMMING

Year 4 started swimming this week as part of their National Curriculum studies. The children swim at Aldershot Pool for half an hour every Thursday morning until Thursday 18th December. These swimming sessions will replace one of your child's PE lessons. Please note these lessons are not optional.

The children will develop their water confidence, safety and ability to swim at three different levels of competence. Swimming instructors have assessed the children during their first session and have grouped them accordingly - school staff are not responsible for groupings during swimming lessons.

Children need to bring a small PE bag with their underwear, towel, swimwear and swimming hat in every Thursday.

Please see below the Clothing and Safety requirements, as requested by Aldershot Pool.

Your child will not be allowed to take part in the swimming lesson if they do not comply with the requirements.

- Goggles optional but advised
- All hair tied back and swimming hats must be worn by all children this is a compulsory requirement from Aldershot
 - **Swimming Pool**
- NO jewellery is to be worn at all, including earrings
- No below the knee shorts or loose-fitting t-shirts. Swim rash vests can be worn
- Females are only allowed to wear a one-piece swimming costume no bikinis / tankinis please
