#### SCHOOL CLUBS

We are pleased to advise that school clubs are available to book online for the Spring Term. All clubs will start from Monday 8<sup>th</sup> January 2024 with the exception of Cricket Club, which starts on Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> February 2024.

If your child is already signed onto a club from this term, their name has been carried over to the same club for next term. Please let the School Office know if you wish for your child to be removed from a club. Please note, that both Ukulele and Library Club have moved times.

If your child would like to join a club, please log on to your Scopay account and sign your child up for their chosen club. If you are unable to sign up online, please pop in or call the School Office and we can sign up your child for their chosen club. Numbers for most clubs are limited for health and safety reasons. You will only be able to sign up for a club if there are spaces available. Therefore, if you are able to sign up online then this guarantees your child a place on that particular club. Please note that if your child does not attend their chosen club on two occasions without letting the teacher or school office know beforehand, their place will be withdrawn.

Please see the list below for club provider information. Clubs highlighted in red are school run clubs and clubs highlighted in yellow are provided by an external company. Clubs run by an external company must be booked through the company and not the school.

Please can we remind you that all school clubs are run by school staff in their own time and we want the children to have fun and enjoy themselves. We therefore expect a high standard of behaviour from all children attending school clubs as well as continued commitment. If at any time your child is unable to attend, please inform the club teacher or the school office as soon as possible. All school run clubs are dismissed through main reception. Please can all parents wait on the playground.
