Year 3 Butser Ancient Farm Trip: Monday 4th March 2024 All day

Year 3 will be visiting Butser Ancient Farm as part of this term's work on The Roman Empire. The children will be taking part in various activities including archaeological excavation, Roman maths, Flint wall building and Villa tour.

The trip will take place on Monday 4th March, leaving school at 9.00am, travelling by coach and returning to school by 3.20pm. The children will need to be in school for registration by 8.40am to enable a prompt departure. The children are required to wear their school uniform and a waterproof coat, and will need a packed lunch and water bottle (in a small named bag that the child can carry). The school can provide a packed lunch at a cost of £3.00.

In order for this trip to go ahead a voluntary contribution of £22.00 is requested to contribute towards the cost of travel and the activities provided by Butser Ancient Farm. Payment is required no later than Friday 9th February 2024.

OTHER INFORMATION

Measles

We have been asked to share the following information with parents:

The UK Health Security Agency (UKHSA) has now declared a national incident in order to focus actions to limit the spread of measles. There are sustained outbreaks in some parts of the country and further outbreaks of measles will spread to other towns and cities unless urgent action is taken to increase Measles, Mumps and Rubella (MMR) vaccination uptake in areas at greatest risk. Children who get measles can be very poorly and some will suffer life changing complications.

To support this incident the Department of Education (DfE) has published: What to do if you think your child has measles and when to keep them off school - The Education Hub (blog.gov.uk) guidance for parents and for schools.
