### Systems and Networks and Sequencing Sounds

- Identify how devices in a network are connected
- Understand the terms 'input' and 'output'
- Build a sequence of commands
- Understand that different sequences can achieve the same and different outputs

- Use appropriate running techniques
- Explore ways to travel
- Throw and catch a ball with accuracy
- Use and understand different types of grips

## RE

### Temptation

- Describe what temptation means
- Understand how Christians believe Jesus was tempted
- Describe how they feel when they are tempted

### Trees as a symbol

- Describe examples of when trees are used as symbols
- Describe what a symbol is
- Understand how the symbol of a tree is used in many religions

## Science

### Animals - Skeletons and Movement

- Understand that animals and humans have skeletons and muscles
- Know that bones and muscles provide support, protection and movement
- Identify vertebrates and invertebrates
- Understand that the denser the bones the more weight they can support

## Music

### Beat

- Understand how patterns fit into a beat
- Identify sounds getting louder and quieter (dynamics)
- Understand the term 'Ostinato'

## Art

### Collage

- Experiment with collage techniques
- Cut complex shapes with accuracy
- Change the surface of materials
- Tear paper to pre-determined shapes

## Spanish

### Pets

- Learn how to ask someone how they are and how to respond
- Learn names of pets and the sounds that they make
- Apply knowledge of numbers and colours to pets
- Learn new adjectives to describe pets

## DT

### Textiles

- Design a product
- Select and use a range of appropriate tools
- Combine securely two pieces of fabric using basic sewing techniques
- Evaluate the development of the design

## Geography/ History

### Italy and Romans

- Describe the physical features (including mountains and key cities) of Italy
- Ask geographical questions about Italy
- Understand the spread of the Roman Empire and describe the consequences of this
- Describe key features of the Roman Empire
- Make reasoned historical judgments based on the Romans
- Educational visit to Butser farm for enrichment

## Maths

### Multiplication and Division and Measure

Some examples of our objectives for this topic are:

- Recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 4 and 8 times tables
- Tell and write the time from a 12-hour clock
- Record and compare time
- Compare durations of events
- Add and subtract amounts of money to give change
