We have organised a visit to the SeaCity Museum Southampton as part of Year 5's Autumn term's work on Titanic. The children will be taking part in various activities related to Titanic.

The visit will take place on Monday 22nd September 2025, leaving school at 9.00 am, travelling by coach and returning to school by 3.20 pm. The children will need to be in school for registration by 8.35am to enable a prompt departure. The party leader will be Mr Edwards.

The children are required to wear their school uniform, a waterproof coat, and will need a packed lunch and water bottle (in a small bag that the child can carry). Please complete the form below and state if you would like the school to provide a packed lunch at a cost of £3.20.

In order for this trip to go ahead a voluntary contribution of £20.50 is requested to contribute towards the cost of travel and the activities provided by SeaCity Museum. If insufficient contributions are received, the visit may have to be cancelled. Payment can be made using Scopay, the online payments facility or cash to the School Office by Friday 12th September. If you are not in a position to be able to make a contribution, you can speak confidentially with Mrs Rachel Woodhouse, the School Business Manager, who is available daily at the school office.

The visit is covered by the County's Insurance policy, a copy of which can be obtained from the office. The school has emergency contact arrangements; the school will be notified of any difficulties by the leader of the party, who will be carrying a mobile phone. Similarly, if there is a family emergency, please contact the school who will contact the party leader.
