The children will need to be in school for registration by 8.35am to enable a prompt departure please. We do require parent helpers on this trip. If you are available to lead a group on this day, please tick the box at the bottom of the permission slip and let the School Office know.

The children are required to wear their school uniform and a waterproof coat, and will need a packed lunch, extra snacks and water bottle (in a small named bag that the child can carry). Please complete the form below if you would like the school to provide a snack pack at a cost of £2.75.

In order for this trip to go ahead, a voluntary contribution of £26.00 is requested to contribute towards the cost of travel and the activities provided by Chessington. If insufficient contributions are received, the visit may have to be cancelled. Payment can be made by cash or via Scopay, the online payments facility by Friday 15th May 2026. If you are not in a position to be able to make a contribution, you can speak confidentially with Mrs Rachel Woodhouse, the School Business Manager, who is available daily at the school office.

The visit is covered by the County's Insurance policy, a copy of which can be obtained from the office.
